## **Lunchtime and After School Clubs**


We have now started to look at the clubs we are able to offer children at lunchtime and after school. Lunchtime clubs will be avilable for all children in Steps 2 and 3. Class teachers will hold the lists for each club and they offer a really lovely range of activities for children to do once they finish eating.

Any clubs after school will be for children in **Step 3 only this term**. Other siblings cannot sit and watch as we are keeping to a strict staff:pupil ratio, each club will have a maximum of 20 children to ensure everyone can enjoy their time (children and staff!). **All clubs after school finish at 4.20pm**. We do have difficulties from time to time with people picking children up late. If parents pick their child up late (more than twice), their child's place in the club will stop and will be offered to someone on the waiting list. 



To vote, you will need to make a purchase within store of any value. You will receive one token per transaction and it's not necessary to purchase a carrier bag in order to receive a token.

#### **Additional information**

Please note the below advice in terms of do's and don'ts before and during the voting period: **Do:** 

- Cast your vote as soon as you receive your token for a project in the current voting round
- Only submit Community Grants tokens to cast your vote
- Encourage the local community and your supporters to get involved with Community Grants voting

#### Don't:

- Tamper with the voting unit (otherwise your project may be void from the vote)
- Influence customers casting their vote at the voting unit
- Take more than one token from the self-serve checkouts
- Promote your project in store without permission from the Store Manager
- Collect Community Grants tokens from stores that are not within your region to vote for your project

Please note, if we do not adhere to this guidance, this may affect our grant award.

## **Booking Lunches**



Please could parents book lunch for their child the day before they need it — it takes up a huge amount of time each day for teachers to ask each child what they would like. Parents are able to book lunches and make menu choices a week in advance. Please do this using Parent Pay.

As more children are now able to have universal free school meals (every child from Reception, Years 1,2 and 3) it is becoming more and more difficult to check every child's bag to see if they have food with them or not.

If we think your child does not have lunch with them will will try to contact you, however, <u>if your child says they are having a school lunch</u> **we believe them** and book a meal on their behalf.

We hate to see children go hungry and our school cook needs to know in advance, cooking meals for almost 100 children every day is quite some task for only 2 people in our tiny kitchen.

Booking your child's meal is essential!

## **Cardiff Half Marathon**

This year's 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Cardiff Half Marathon will be featuring a series of Junior Races on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> September. These will include:

- **Family Fun Run** A 1-mile run designed for all the family, with no pressure on finishing times. Suitable for all primary school ages.
- **Future Challengers** A competitive race for young and eager runners at junior level. Suitable for ages 8-17.
- **Toddler Dash** A 50m dash aimed at children aged 3 and under.

## **Fundraising Bake Sales**

## School Essentials Grant

Children whose families are on lower incomes and qualify for certain benefits can apply for a grant of:

- · £125 per learner
- £200 for learners entering year 7 (to help with increased costs associated with starting secondary school)

All compulsory school years from reception to year 11 are now eligible.

All looked after children qualify for the grant, whether they receive free school meals or not. Learners who receive free school meals due to transitional protection arrangements do not qualify.

Families are only entitled to claim once per child, per school year.

The 2023 to 2024 scheme is now open and will close on 31 May 2024.

## The School Street at St Monicas CIW Primary School

St Monicas CIW Primary School is an Active Travel School and has a School Street.

A School Street is a street near a school where traffic is restricted at the beginning and end of the school day. The times that <u>Cwmdare</u> and <u>Pentyrch</u> Street will be a School Street is from **8:30am to 9:30am and 3pm to 4pm**. School Streets are operational Monday to Friday, term time only. Only vehicles with valid School Street permits, such as residents and blue badge holders, will be allowed to drive down the street.

We encourage families, staff and visitors to travel to us as actively as possible. Not only is this safer and healthier for our pupils, this forms part of Cardiff Council's vision to change the way people travel around the city and make changes to respond to the climate emergency, for clean air and to create safe and healthy communities.

This means that we ask you to walk, cycle or scoot to us if you possibly can, or use public transport to get to us. We try to limit cars to our school, if you feel you have to travel by car then please park 10 minutes away and walk the last leg of your journey to school. This ensures all of our pupils are safe.
