

6th February 2024 Ending the half term with lifelong memories!



Our children are truly amazing - children in Steps 2 and 3 took part in the TTRS NSPCC ROCKS UK Competition on Friday 2nd February. We have found that practising our 'Learn Its' through TTRS has really helped our children's very quick recall of essential maths facts. This then helps them to grapple with the maths processes needed.

Wales results - 119 schools took part, there were 613 classes with 7813 children
The children were absolutely incredible and, once again, we were the top school in Cardiff! In fact, as a whole school we came 4th in Wales.

Mrs Irwin's maths class coming 3rd in Wales.

Two of our Year 5 boys did exceptionally well, Muhammed Mahad came in at number 30 and Daniel Asmelash at number 37 in Wales!

UK results - 3793 schools took part, there were 22,268 classes with 277,522 children As a school we came 50th in the UK. Mrs Irwin's class came in at a very respectable 45.

Check out our X (Twitter) feed to see lovely photos and videos of our children who are certainly out and about - exploring Wales by train no less. 36 of our children are currently in Longtown - and 32 children visited Barry Island only yesterday.

Mrs Meakins and Mr Thomas led a great internet safety workshop for parents and children at the end of the day last week. All of the resources from all workshops can be found on the school website. There are some useful parent guides and aids with some helpful hints and tips about internet safety and gnarly issues such as 'How much screen time is appropriate for my child?'

I couldn't be prouder of the children and staff in St Monica's. The learning that goes on inside and outside of our building is staggering and it's so lovely to see everyone SHINE as they take on new responsibilities and new opportunities for learning.
