All you need to do is pick up a blue voting token — in any Tesco store in Cardiff, and drop it into the St Monica's slot in the plastic voting station which is usually by the entrance of each store.

Safety at the beginning and end of each day



I don't ever like to use the newsletter to air complaints, however, due to the very real risk to everyone's safety I have to raise this...

I have had several complaints this week, from members of the community about some **near-miss accidents** just outside our school. They have **involved St Monica's pupils** and are linked to how children have been **dropped off or picked up** each day. Please can you ensure that you always park in a safe place and look before you allow your child to open car doors. Younger children will need close supervision.

Children have also been running around at high speed on the schoool playground at the end of the school day, there was a bad accident earlier this week which resulted in a child breaking their arm. There are nearly 150 children (not including younger siblings) plus parents and family members. **There can be nearly 250 people all accessing the same small area.** Once your child has been dismissed to you, **please keep them with you at all times** and do not allow them to chase around the playground or to use their scooter or bicycle until outside the school gates.

The best way to come to school is to walk wherever possible — with the new speed limits in place across Wales, this should be even safer to do! We are a WOW Travel Tracker School, the challenge this year is for all children to travel sustainably (walk, scoot or cycle) once a week for a month — every child that does that gets rewarded with badges, a different badge for each month, there are 11 to collect.
