

## How to get to St Monica's School

St Monica's CIW Primary School is an Active Travel School. The streets right next to us are called Pentyrch Street and Cwmdare Street (see map below). The end of Pentyrch Street along with Cwmdare Street are '**School Streets**'. This means that you must not drive down these during school drop off and pick up times (8.30am - 9.30am; 3.00pm - 4.00pm). The reason is to help keep pupils safe from traffic during these times. **Anybody driving down these streets during drop off and pick up times will receive a Penalty Charge Notice - 'PCN' - which means that you will be fined.**

We encourage families, staff and visitors to travel to us as actively as possible. This is part of Cardiff Council's vision by 2030 to change the way people travel around the city and make changes to respond to the climate emergency, for clean air and to create safe and healthy communities.

This means that we ask you to walk, cycle or scoot to us if you possibly can, or use public transport to visit us. We try to limit cars to our school. However, if you feel you have to travel by car then please park 10 minutes away and walk to us. This ensures all of our pupils are safe.


## Public Transport: By Train



