MMR Vaccinations

We are supporting Public Health Wales by opening up as a vaccination centre for all children (and staff) in St Monica's who are not currently vaccinated against Measles, Mumps or Rubella. This is **TOMORROW** THURSDAY 11th April 3-5.30pm.

It is very important that your child is vaccinated, measles in particular is a very dangerous and contagious illness. It is particularly dangerous for children. Anyone unvaccinated who comes into contact with **an infected person has to isolate for 30 days** - this is much longer than we previously had to do for COVID-19. The risk of measles is higher for pupils in our school as so many children are either unvaccinated or have not had any overseas vaccinations recorded with their GP. This means that any 'herd immunity' that might have been present a few years ago, is no longer sufficient to protect them.

Children have already been so severely affected by isolation and control measures from the pandemic, it would be awful to return to a similar, if not worse, situation.

If you are **unsure** about your child's vaccination status, please **contact your GP** surgery. If you know your child has had only 1 vaccination, or not had any MMR vaccinations then they can receive the vaccination in school on Thursday 11th April. I have been told that it isn't a problem if someone ends up having 3 vaccinations.

Your child will **not be vaccinated unless full parental permission** has been given, the session is for after school so parents can also be present. We will be directly phoning all families of children identified as not having had the vaccination so they are able to make a fully informed decision about taking up the offer of vaccination.

If you have not had a phone call but know your child has not had their MMR vaccinations, or has had them in another country and you are not sure if they are of the right variety, please contact us in school.

St Monica's University - SMU

After a considerable planning period, we are now ready to start our St Monica's University each Friday afternoon as a 4 week pilot project! The SMU will have a core focus on wider maths skills (from Big Maths) where the gaps each child currently has in their knowledge and understanding will be taught. Children will be in small mixed age groups and taught by teachers in very focused sessions. This week children are selecting from a menu of electives, which all have either a Health & Wellbeing or Expressive Arts focus. These will be taught by Teaching Assistants and/or (carefully selected, DBS checked) volunteers, again in mixed age groups.

I look forward to seeing how this pilot progresses and the (hopefully) positive impact it has on children's wider maths skills and their enjoyment and engagement with their learning.

If you would like to support the SMU in June, and can commit to all 4 Friday afternoons, and have ideas of an elective that you think children would enjoy, please do get in touch. It can take a little time for a DBS check to come back, so now would be the best time to apply for one - it doesn't cost us any money but is essential if you would like to help/volunteer in the school. The DBS is the Disclosure and Barring Service check, sometimes known as a Police check. This ensures that anyone coming into the school has had checks made into their background which gives us some reassurance that only the safest people come into contact with our children.

Year 6 Celebration

On **Friday 19th April, at 2.40pm** there will be a celebration/presentation for all children in **Year 6,** related to their successes in the Flourish Project with Mrs Meakins and Kate from The Table. <u>https://protonfoundation.com/flourish-project/</u> You will hear from Mrs Meakins and Kate about how the children have developed their confidence as they further develop a growth mindset and have learned about creating helpful thinking patterns. Our Year 6's have started to understand their potential, how they can realise future aspirations and set goals for the future. This celebration is always a joyous event and I hope as many Year 6 parents as possible are able to come.
