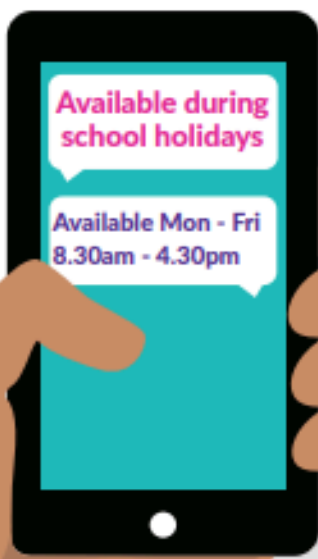

We might inform someone if we were concerned about your safety, but we would usually speak to you first. Your messages are stored and can be seen by other healthcare staff who follow the same confidentiality rules. We aim to reply to you within one working day and you should get an immediate message back to confirm we received your text. Texts will not be seen outside normal working hours. If you need help before you hear back from us, contact your GP, nearest walk in centre or dial 111. Our text number does not receive voice calls or MMS picture messages. We support messaging from UK mobile numbers only (which does not include messages sent from landlines, international mobile numbers and some 'number masking' mobile apps). To prevent the health professional from sending messages to you, text STOP to our number. Messages are charged at your usual rates.

Girls Golf Cymru aims to introduce golf to girls and encourages further participation in the sport through creating a fun and fluid environment. The Girls Golf Cymru Clinics are tailored towards junior girls (U18), for those who are members at a golf club AND those who have never played golf before. The clinics are a great way for young people to meet others who play golf, build friendships, and experience playing different golf courses.

It is an all-day event delivered by PGA professionals, starting with technical work (e.g. putting and chipping) in the morning, followed by a break for lunch as provided by the club, and spending the afternoon on the golf course. This provides the girls with an opportunity to improve their skill, gain a WHS Handicap Index, and to play more competitive golf. Various competitions will be run throughout the day to encourage and challenge the girls to develop further e.g. longest drive.

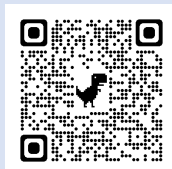

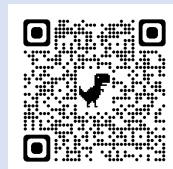

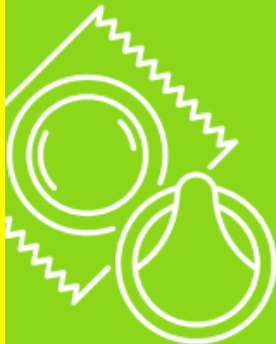
